Our program on January 24th will be on woodburning by Randy Mayes. This should be a useful program to all wanting to embellish/enhance their projects. The raffle prize will be a collection of various sizes and grits of sandpaper that anyone will be able to use.

I have been cleaning out my shop and basement. I have found numerous items that my father gave me when they moved from Columbia 8 years ago that I will never use. Some of these items are: Delta table saw miter gauge hold down, Delta table saw trunnion adjustments, 12" cut off blades, 1" Delta sanding belts and other items.
