A) 101 Conley Rd, Columbia, MO 65211-0001 US

1. Start out going SOUTH on CONLEY RD toward BRICKTON RD. (go 0.1 miles)
2. CONLEY RD becomes TRIMBLE RD. (go 0.3 miles)
3. Turn LEFT onto E BROADWAY/MO-WW. (go 0.3 miles)
4. Merge onto US-63 S. (go 26.7 miles)
5. Merge onto US-54 W/US-63 S/CF RED WHALEY EXPY toward JEFFERSON CITY. (go 1.5 miles)
6. Merge onto US-50 W toward SEDALIA. (go 5.5 miles)
7. Take the ramp toward APACHE FLATS/ST MARTINS. (go 0.2 miles)
8. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto US-50 BR/US-50-BR W/BUSINESS 50 W. (go 1.4 miles)
9. End at 5927 Business 50 W Jefferson City, MO 65109-0020
